Subject: Recognition Certificate for the school under sub-rule (4) of rule 11 of Delhi Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 for the purpose of section 18 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to provisional recognition up to Elementary level granted to your school under RTE Act, 2009 vide letter **No.DE./15/Act-I/Rec./JPS/South/2013/12844-52, dated 19.12.2013** for a period of one year w.e.f. 01-04-2013 to 31-03-2014 and subsequent inspection of the school and fulfilment of terms and conditions of provisional recognition letter dated 01.01.2014, I convey the approval of grant of further extension of provisional recognition up to Elementary level to **The Jagruti Public School, F-2/152, Main Road, Ratia Mart, Sangam Vihar, Delhi for Class Ist to Class VIIIth for further period of two year i.e. up to 31-03-2016.**

The above provisional recognition is subject to fulfilment of following conditions:

01. The grant of provisional recognition does not in any way imply any obligation for recognition beyond class VIII.
02. The School shall abide by the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Delhi Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011.

03. The School shall admit in class I (or in entry class, as the case may be), to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighbourhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion.
04. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the School shall be reimbursed in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (2) of section 12 of the Act. To receive such reimbursements school shall maintain a separate bank account.
05. The Society/School shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parent or guardian to any screening procedure.
06. The School shall not deny admission to any child for lack of age of proof and shall adhere to the provisions of section 15 of the Act. The school shall ensure:
 - (a) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school.
 - (ii) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
 - (iii) No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education.
 - (iv) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down in under rule 22 of Delhi Right of children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules 2011.
 - (v) The students with disabilities/special needs are given inclusive education as per provision of the Act.
 - (vi) The teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications as laid under section 23(1) of the Act. Provided further that the current teachers who, at the commencement of this Act do not possess minimum qualifications shall acquire such minimum qualifications within a period of 5 years.
 - (vii) The teachers performs their duties as specified under section 24(1) of the Right of children to Free and compulsory Education Act 2009 and the teachers shall not engage himself / herself for private coaching.
07. The School shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by appropriate authority/ NCERT as the case may be.
08. The School shall follow the three language formula for teaching.

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09. A certificate from competent authority that the school building has been constructed as per latest National Building Code has to be submitted within three months.
10. That the Management of the school shall maintain a reserve fund in the form of Fixed Deposit in the joint account in the name of Manager of the school and Dy. Director of Education (District concerned) equivalent to 3 months salary of staff or Rupees One Lac+Rs. 80/- per student within 3 months from the date of issue of letter.
11. That the School shall ensure that the Fire Safety equipments and arrangements are maintained as per the latest guidelines/circulars issued by Directorate of Education.
12. That the School shall comply with the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India regarding the arrangement made for transporting school students.
13. Salary to the staff shall be paid through crossed Cheque/Electronic clearance system.
14. The School shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in section 19 of the Right of children to Free and Compulsory Act 2009 and the instructions/orders issued from time to time. The facilities reported in at the time of last inspection are as under:-

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15. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of the school.
16. The school building or other structure or the grounds are used only for the purposes of education and skill development of children.
17. The School is run by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860), or a public trust constituted under any law for the time being in force.
18. The School is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other persons.
19. The school accounts are audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper account statements should be prepared as per rules. A copy of each of the statements of Accounts should be sent to the District Education Officer every year.
20. The provisional recognition Code Number allotted to the school may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with the appropriate authority.
21. The School furnishes such reports and information as may be required by the appropriate authority/ Government from time to time and complies with such instructions of the Appropriate Government/Local Authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfilment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.
22. Renewal of Registration of Society if any be ensured.

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23. Other conditions:



- (a) Final outcome of the notification of MoUD, Govt. of India.
- (b) Appointment of adequate teaching and non-teaching staff in the school as per requirement and RRs laid down by the Department.
- (c) The payment of salary and other allowances/benefits to the staff shall be made in accordance with 6th CPC and through Bank/Cheque/RTGS.
- (d) The School shall properly maintain Depreciation Reserve Fund account.
- (e) That the school shall appoint two Special Educators/Medical Officers, as per norms of the Department.
- (f) Ensuring fulfilment of all the norms and conditions under DSEAR, 1973, RTE Act, 2009 and directions issued by the Department from time to time.
